However, we also have members who neither hunt with nor test their dogs; they come out for the opportunity to work with their dogs in a simulated hunt/test atmosphere.

1) Marking – is the dog's ability to make a mental note of the location of the downed bird when allowed to see the fall. A dog will retain that in memory until he is sent out to retrieve. Proficiency can be shown by reaching the area of the fall and systematically hunting it out, or moving directly to the bird. 2) Style – is measured by its eagerness to locate and retrieve in an enthusiastic manner. They should appear happy and excited yet obedient and alert in pursuing the fall.

3) Perseverance – is shown by determination to stick to it and complete the job.

There should be a willingness to face rough cover with no hesitation and should demonstrate systematic and aggressive searching.

4) Trainability – evaluates a dog's steadiness, control, response and delivery. A dog should not break or leave the line until the handler gives the command.
